Night Prayer derives its content from the wisdom of the centuries in Scripture and above all in the psalms, but also from contemporary Christian experience of God.

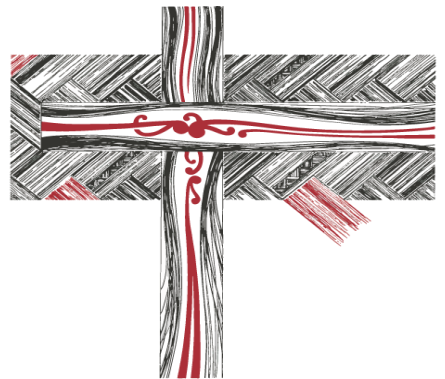
It celebrates the awareness that each of us who tries to pray is a part of the human whole.
